Black Physicians of Tomorrow (BPT) exists to provide African, Caribbean, Canadian (ACC) individuals with the tools and resources needed to prepare for and attain, careers in the field of medicine and the allied health professions.

Our goal at the STEMWORKS program is to provide a space, resources, and opportunities for Black youth (age 12-19) living within Durham region experiencing the barriers that discourage them from obtaining careers in medicine and the allied health professions.

Through the STEM Works program, we hope to improve STEM literacy among Black youth, while encouraging them in their personal development through mentorship and life skills workshops. We are looking for energetic, friendly, and committed individuals who are willing to work with Black youth in a tutoring setting (1:3 teacher/student ratio). We thank all applicants, but only those chosen for an interview will be contacted.

All successful applicants will be required to get a Criminal Record Check (Vulnerable Sector), reimbursement will be provided
